EMERGENCY INFORMATION

In an emergency or life threatening situation dial 999

IN THE EVENT OF THE FIRE ALARM SOUNDING

Please evacuate the building as quickly and calmly as possible to the assembly point which is located in both front and back car parks of the hotel. **Do not re-enter the building until authorised to do so.**

Please familiarise yourself with your means of escape which is as follows: Mercer, Keith, Lansdowne, Murray, Nairne

From your room make your way along the corridor and turn right or down the stairs to the back hotel entrance. When outside the building make your way to the assembly point: **Hortense & Flahaut**

Come down the stairs from your rooms and go straight along the corridor to the fire exit. Turn left outside the building and make your way to the assembly point in the back car park: **Crawlaw, Damee, Lunan, Isla**

Proceed from your rooms and out the main door for the building.

Turn right outside and make your way to the assembly point in the carpark. A roll call of all residents will be taken.

IN THE EVENT OF FINDING A FIRE

If the alarm has not already been activated, press one of the fire alarm call points (first floor landings and by all exit doors).

Dial 999 and ask for the Fire Service.

Evacuate the building in line with the instructions above.

FIRE ALARM TEST

Our weekly test of the fire alarm will take place around 11:00am every Tuesday.

IN THE EVENT OF A POWER FAILURE

- Emergency lighting will operate for about 2 hours.
- The fire alarm panel will bleep but it is still operational.
- Heating & hot water systems will cease operation.

Our lady owner is from Bordeaux and we have our very own house claret, "le Nid du Héron".

BEDROOM CLEANING

LINEN

Please use the sign "make my room" and your bedroom will be serviced by our housekeepers, with a linen change over on every third day of your stay. However, if you do need any additional bedding, linen or the beds changed sooner please don't hesitate in asking.

TOWELS

Please help us maintain our commitment to being environmentally friendly by preventing the unnecessary washing of towelling. If you leave your towels in the bath/shower, we will gladly change them, if you leave your towels on the rail, you are happy to re-use them.

PETS

We are a dog friendly hotel with dedicated dog-friendly rooms which are thoroughly steam-cleaned after each visit. We kindly ask that they are kept off the soft furnishings throughout the hotel, if you have forgotten their bed we have some washable ones to borrow as well as doggy towels. We kindly ask you **NOT** to leave your dog alone in the room, there are areas in the restaurant for pet owners. There is an outside tap available to wash any muddy paws before coming into the hotel (applies for welly boots as well!).

Pets stay for free but we hope you will understand why a fee may be charged if extensive cleaning of any bedroom is required or if furnishings need to be dry-cleaned or repaired.



THINGS TO DO

SALMON FISHING

The Meikleour Arms has been serving anglers for more than 200 years. The River Tay is one of the most productive salmon rivers in the UK and attracts anglers from all over the world. The largest salmon ever caught in the UK, 64lbs, was caught by a lady just minutes away from our building.

The season starts on the 15th of January (we are proud to host the official opening ceremony of the river) and finishes on the 15th of October.

For conservation purposes the River operates a "catch and release" policy which means that all salmon caught must be promptly and safely put back in the water. It is a criminal offense to kill a wild salmon between the 15th of January and the 31st of March.

Meikleour Estate maintain their own salmon fishing beat, the iconic Upper Islamouth and Meikleour beat (www. islamouth.co.uk). We welcome anglers of all levels and provide equipment if necessary. The most enjoyable and safest way to discover and appreciate the mighty Tay is from a traditional Tay wooden cobble with your personal Ghillie. Our guided day boat salmon fishing price starts at £150/day for up to two anglers, with equipment and standard tuition included.

There are many other beats around us that we would happily recommend, just ask us.

THINGS TO DO

WATER SPORTS

Willow Gate Activity Centre in Perth offers excellent Kayak guided tours around the Tay estuary and boat trips from Perth to Dundee.

WALKING & HIKING

The village of Meikleour is the ideal place for guests looking to enjoy the outdoors.

We highly recommend a walk along the Estate's beautiful North Wood (take the path on the left of the restaurant entrance) or a walk along the river Tay. Our pebble beach will delight bird watchers but we kindly ask you to keep dogs under control especially during the spring and the salmon spawning season (Nov-Dec).

For walks a little further afield, here are a few you may be interested in:

- The Bluebell Woods, Kinclaven Beautiful in May, awash with a carpet of bluebells.
- The Hermitage, Dunkeld Towering Douglas firs, a spectacular waterfall and a picture sque folly.
- Bealach na Searmon, Pitlochry Woodland and open hillside leading to a walk along the River Garry.

Scotland's Oldest Working Distillery and a beautiful visitor area owned by French luxury crystal maker Lalique.

THE HOUSE OF BRUAR

The House of Bruar sits at the foot of the Bruar Falls near Blair Atholl Castle. Widely acknowledged as the Harrods of the Highlands it has everything Scottish; from fine cashmere, high-end tablet to artwork. If you are a small group they are happy to welcome you for a complimentary guided tour (the shop is vast!).

AIRPORTS

Edinburgh International Airport is 53 miles away, so allow at least 1 hr 30 minutes depending on the traffic over the Queensferry Crossing Bridge.

Glasgow International Airport is situated on the south side of Glasgow. It is 78 miles away, so allow 2 hours depending on the time of day for the Glasgow traffic.

Dundee Airport is 30 minutes away and has regular flights from and to London City.
